In garment making there are many different seams used in construction. Some are utilitarian, while others are decorative. Some of those seaming techniques are what you will be exploring in this class. You will be using some of those seaming technique to create fabric that can be used to create garments, purses, little bags, wall hanging, evening bags, sachet or special pillows.

Supplies you should bring to the workshop:

Fabric requirements:

A variety of fabrics: Your choice of solid or sheer Jacquard, Dotted Swiss, Batiste, Organdy or Cotton. You may mix fabrics: white on white, tone on tone or a mix of colored fabrics. ¼ yards are fine.

Embellishment: Opt. Beads, bits of ribbon, small buttons and thread:
Perle cotton, silk, sashiko or quilting

General requirements:

- Sewing machine and extra needles
- Extension cord (if needed for facility)
- Iron
- Basic sewing kit
- Awl (opt)
- Straight seam foot
- Edge stitch foot
- Pencil and notepad
- Rotary cutter & board
- Omnigrid or quilter's ruler
- Sense of adventure along with a sense of humor!
